



EV Charging Etiquette

Please respect the need for Electric Vehicles (EV) and Plug-In Hybrid Vehicles (PHEV) to plug-in, by maintaining the availability of these designated spaces for their use.

Charging Time Limits:

Level Three (fast charge) – 30 minutes

Level Two (medium charge) – 3 hours maximum

- Ⓢ Don't charge if you don't need to. Leave the spot free for another EV driver that might really need the charge.
- Ⓢ Communication is key. Leave a note letting others know when you will return to move your car.
- Ⓢ Please be courteous and move your charged vehicle to make space for others in need. Think of these spots as a pull through gas station. It's not a spot intended for you to park and stay all day. There are many others who need to charge.
- Ⓢ It's fine to unplug another car if the first car has clearly finished charging. Simply leave a note explaining why it was unplugged.
- Ⓢ Please properly hang cord after each use.
- Ⓢ Place cord safely to avoid a tripping hazard.
